SCOPE AND CONTENT

This collection consists of 24 manuscript boxes recording deaths, marriages, admissions and removals. Reports of various church officials, i.e., trustees, treasurers and clerks are filed chronologically, wherever possible.

HISTORICAL SKETCH

Although the town of Thetford was created by charter in 1761, it was not until 1773 that it voted to provide for a minister, the Reverend Clement Sumner, when eleven members "laid in the foundation of the church." In 1778, Asa Burton became pastor and remained for over fifty years. The early records of the church are all in his handwriting and include a transcript of the marriages, deaths, admissions and removals. This information was not recorded elsewhere, therefore it became a primary source of town vital records.

In 1781, a log cabin was built to serve the congregation, but by 1787 a more permanent building was erected on what is now the village common. Moved in 1830 on wooden rollers to its present location, the church has been renovated over the years with the addition of a tower, clock, vestibule and pews. In 1953, a major addition included Sunday School rooms, kitchen, office and gathering room. In 2004, a further addition brought the building into compliance with federal accessibility and safety regulations. The First Congregational Church is believed to be the "oldest church in continuous use in the State of Vermont."
